**Collection Wines in Sideboard:** genuine wines that accompany you throughout the meal, versatile to pair with food.

*This smooth and balanced wine is a good match with roasted and braised meat, but also with flavourful, vegetable risottos. It shows that simplicity is the ultimate sophistication.*



**GRAPE VARIETY:** 60% Barbera, 40% Croatina

**TERROIR:** vineyards are located in Albareto, in the district of Ziano Piacentino (Piacenza); the plantation dates back to 2000 and it is placed on a hillside with a gradient of 15%. The plot has a clay soil, it is 200 m above the sea level and it is facing South-West. Vines are trained using the espalier technique and pruned by the Guyot system with a planting pattern of 2.4 x 1.4 m. Planting density is 3000 vines/ha and the yearly yield per hectare is 10000 kg.

**HARVEST AND VINIFICATION:** grapes are harvested in the middle of September. Maceration lasts for 8-10 days. Frequent pumping over and a macro-oxygenation allow an optimization of the extraction and fermentation process. Fermentation takes place at a temperature between 25°-28° C.

**MATURATION:** 1 year, 20% in barriques, 80% in concrete

**REFINEMENT:** 3 months in the bottle

**ALCOHOL CONTENT:** 14% vol

**RESIDUAL SUGAR:** <2 g/l

**TOTAL ACIDITY:** 5.6 g/l in tartaric acid

**COLOUR:** garnet red.

**NOSE:** vinous, light spicy notes of black pepper and vegetal scents in the background.

**PALATE:** balanced, elegant, with gentle spicy and vegetal notes.

**FOOD PAIRING:** it enhances roast, braised dishes, stew and game; it is also perfect for medium-hard cheeses, soy-based preparations and vegetable risottos, potatoes or squash.

**RECOMMENDED GLASS:** Bordeaux or Ballon glass; to be served at 18° C.

**FIRST VINTAGE:** 1971

**PACKAGING:** 750 ml Bordeaux bottle, 6 per case; also available in gift box.

**PRODUCTION:** 5000 bottles/year (750 ml).
